Since we met on April 30, 2015 during the State of the City presentation, many changes have taken place. My administration and I are continuing to work toward goals that will have little impact on you while still maintaining the same level of service. One of the ways that has been accomplished is through discussions with our refuse vendor to provide you the ability to continue putting out yard waste and other refuse on your regular refuse day. Our refuse provider agreed on a two refuse can maximum that can include yard waste so long as it's contained in a plastic bag within the trash can. Anything exceeding the two can maximum can be brought to the service garage Monday through Friday from 7:00am-7:00pm or on Saturdays from 8:00am-12:00pm.
